In the same year he completed a PhD in Medicine at the the University of Adelaide with a Thesis on the Pathogenesis of Intervertebral Disc Degeneration.

Since 1993 Dr. Osti has practiced in Adelaide as an Orthopaedic Surgeon with a special interest in the assessment and management of spinal disorders. He is a Senior Clinical Lecturer at the University of Adelaide and is the author of more than fifty original scientific publications in the field of spinal disorders. He was awarded the International Volvo Award for spinal research in 1986 and 1990. He currently chairs the Spinal and Neurosurgical Clinical Advisory Group of the Commonwealth Dept. of Health (SNEGAG) and is a Member of the Advocacy Committee of the Australian Orthopaedic Association (AOA)
